



## **CLASS OF 2018**

- 114 graduates completed their degrees from July 1, 2017, to June 30, 2018
- Knowledge rate for Class of 2018: 94% (107 out of 114)
- Successful placement rate for Class of 2018: 95% (102 out of 107)


